2024-25 Quarter 3 (October – December 2024)

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01 PORTFOLIO DIRECTOR SUMMARY

During the quarter we saw the Parc Bryn Cegin Outline Business Case approved by the Economic Ambition Board: The aim of the project is to provide modern energy efficient low carbon employment units at Parc Bryn Cegin, Bangor creating new employment and business expansion opportunities. The planning application for the site has also been submitted to Cyngor Gwynedd for consideration. The Full Business Case for the project is currently being developed and will be presented for Board approval early in the new year.

The Economic Ambition Board also approved the change request for the swing inclusion in the Responsible Adventure Project, the Outline business Case for the project is being finalised ready for presenting through the approval process in January/February.

The updated Portfolio Business Case has now been approved by the Board and submitted to Welsh and UK Governments as part of the annual award of funding process.

The annual Portfolio Gateway Review of the Growth Deal was carried out by a panel of independent experts during October. The Portfolio Management Office are currently working on addressing the 4 recommendations set out in the report.

During the quarter we successfully appointed two fund advisors to prepare and mobilise our Clean Energy Fund, which will launch in 2025. WCVA will work in conjunction with Community Energy Wales on a voluntary sector sub-fund and Umi will lead the sub-fun targeting the private sector. The investment strategy is being developed for the fund in preparation for the Full Business Case approval.

Industry consultation for the Connected Key Sites and Corridors 4G+ project concluded during the quarter; valuable feedback was received to guide the design of the interventions. The Advanced Wireless project commenced market engagement following OBC approval last quarter.

Both projects within the Innovation in High Value Manufacturing programme are progressing well. Construction of the Enterprise Engineering and Optics Centre is progressing well with the building watertight and internal fixtures being made., Hedd and Elliw visited the site to see the progress during the quarter. Work on the refurbishment of the Henfaes site for the Centre for Environmental Biotechnology project is on schedule.

December saw several of the Shared Prosperity Funded workstreams draw to a close. The team have secured an extension to the project timescale in order to wrap up other workstreams. Core work on SPF project assessing feasibility of public sector asset 'access agreements' for telecoms use concluded this quarter with positive results.

Looking forward 2025 sets out to be an exciting year for Ambition North Wales and the Growth Deal. Work is progressing to transfer the Growth Deal and the Portfolio Management Office team into the Corporate Joint Committee by 1st of April. We are on track to see a number of projects move into delivery during the year.

Portfolio Business Case		The Portfolio Business Case 2024 update was approved by the Economic Ambition Board in October and has been submitted to Welsh Government and UK Government as part of the annual award of funding process.
Delivery Pipeline		The delivery pipeline is consistent with the 2024 Portfolio Business Case, with projects reporting against this timetable currently
Governance		The Portfolio, Programme and Project Management Framework is now well established with the Portfolio Board and five Programme Boards operating effectively. A Conflicts of Interest procedure is in place across all Boards.
Assurance		The fifth annual Growth Deal assurance review (Programme Assurance Review) was completed in October 2024 with the report delivering a 'Red' confidence rating for the portfolio. A follow up Assurance of Action Plan (AAP) review will take place in April 2025.
Resource and Capacity		The Low Carbon Energy Programme Manager will leave his role in January 2025; an interim Low Carbon Energy Programme Manager has been appointed for 6 months whilst we appoint the replacement. The recruitment campaign is currently underway. Fixed term contracts (not including staff funded by LEAP or SPF) currently run until March 2026, reducing the risk of staff leaving in the short term.
Finance		A total of £8.47m Growth Deal funding has been spent to date. This included £2.15m on the Digital Signal Processing Centre, £4.81m on the Enterprise Engineering & Optics Centre and £1.51m to fund the revenue expenditure.
Investment		Securing the public and private sector investment required to deliver the Growth Deal remains a significant risk across the portfolio. The Economic Ambition Board approved the Investment Strategy during their meeting in March 2024.
Risk		Overall risk profile remains consistent with Quarter 2. Procurement of the support services framework (2023 PAR recommendation) is underway and due to be appointed in Q4. A number of high residual risks remain which are being managed by the PMO including affordability, consenting, delay and investment.
Benefits Monitoring & Evaluation		Trainings have been held with Ambition North Wales and Project Sponsors in how to use the Benefits Reporting platform. Projects have all uploaded their indicators, both projects that are in delivery have started populating the platform enabling the project, programme and portfolio teams to track progress towards spending objectives and benefits.
Emissions and Biodiversity		The final draft of the streamlined methodology is currently being finalised, ready to be shared early in 2025. Discussions are underway to consider supporting a small number of Local Authorities as 'Pioneer Councils' to held embed the methodology. Led by subject matter experts from Grant Thornton and Arup, two virtual training sessions took place in November 2024, with around 70 local authority and environmental officers attending.
Communication and Engagement		Press releases were issued on the approval of the outline business case for the Advanced Wireless project; the election of our new Chair and Vice-chair, our SPF funded Rural Digital Connectivity project, new Agri-Food Tech Launchpad funding, the Deeside Anaerobic Digestion Plant project securing full private sector investment, and the appointment of fund advisors to mobilise our Clean Energy Fund. We worked with Business News Wales to produce a Podcast focusing on the role of Ambition North Wales, which was supported by articles from members of the PMO. Our social media channels covered promotion of our social value workshop, contributions at events, recruitment, tender opportunities, and a package of end of year highlights to bring 2024 to a close. Our engagement and reach on social media continued to grow and there were 8.4k active users of our website.

Programme Manager Commentary In depth industry consultation for the Connected Key Sites and Corridors '4G+' project concluded this quarter, with valuable feedback received to guide the design of the four proposed interventions. Preparations for the Full Business Case are now well advanced. Core work on SPF project assessing feasibility of public sector asset 'access agreements' for telecoms use concluded this quarter with positive results. The Connected Campuses LPWAN project is now in network design stage with capital procurement due to start next quarter. The Advanced Wireless project has started market engagement following OBC approval last quarter. Dependencies remain for Last Few % and Full Fibre projects, associated with UK Government Project Gigabit broadband investment with all regional contracts expected to be awarded by next quarter, providing clarity on scope for Growth Deal intervention.

- The Tourism Talent Network's Grant Funding Agreement is nearing completion. Selection of the final spoke has been presented, Grwp Llandrillo-Menai are drafting a Business Justification Case for full endorsement. Snowdonia Hospitality and Leisure's decision to withdraw from needing Growth Deal funding, replacement spoke selection in process.


