There are many experienced bid writing suppliers who aim to give you the best chance of success with your funding application. That said, the final decision on grant awards is entirely up to the funding provider, and there are no guarantees.

These services are all about making your application as strong as possible, ensuring it ticks all the right boxes and showcases your strengths. But keep in mind, there are factors outside the supplier's control that can impact the outcome, including:

- How many others are applying and the level of competition.
- The grant provider's specific priorities and decisions.
- Any changes to funding or grant terms.

By choosing one of these suppliers, you're agreeing that they aren't responsible if your application isn't successful. Their fees cover the time, expertise, and effort they put into creating your bid, no matter the result.
