- Archwilio atebion arloesol i reali gwastraff bwyd.

Dyrianiad Adnoddau

- Darparu cyllid a chymorth i alluogi mentrau bwyd lleol amrywiol i alinio a gweithio gyda'i gilydd tuag at nodau cynaliadwyedd.
- Cynnig cyllid grant i ysgogi busnesau newydd lleol, yn ogystal â chymhell busnesau i dyfu a gwerthu bwyd lleol.
- Darparu cefnogaeth ariannol a buddsoddiad i dyfu'r sector twristiaeth bwyd. Gallai hyn gynnwys cyllid grant i ariannu gwyliau bwyd mewn cymunedau lleol, cynyddu gwerthiant i gynhyrchwyr lleol, ehangu eu marchnadoedd a chryfhau'r diwylliant bwyd ymhliith y boblogaeth leol.
- Defnyddio offer gorfodi, yn amrywio o ganllawiau busnes i gamau cyfreithiol, i sicrhau cydymffurfiaeth â rheoliadau sy'n gysylltiedig â bwyd.

North Wales Agri food Report Summary: For Local Authority Economic Development Teams

Local Authority economic development teams play a crucial role in supporting local food through achieving inclusive, sustainable local economies. Through a combination of knowledge, expertise, and skills, they are crucial in attracting investment into the local area. Economic development teams can capitalise on trends such as green growth and automation, creating high-quality jobs within the local food and drink sector. Their focus also includes addressing social and economic inequalities.

Enablers

Infrastructure Development

- Create and maintain infrastructure such as processing facilities, storage facilities, wholesale markets, street trading areas, and slaughterhouses. These facilities contribute to short food supply chains and support local food initiatives.
- Explore innovative solutions to managing food waste.

Resource Allocation

- Provide funding and support to enable diverse local food initiatives to align and work together toward sustainability goals.
- Offer grant funding to stimulate local start-up businesses, as well as incentivising businesses to grow and sell local food.
- Provide financial support and investment to grow the food tourism sector. This could include grant funding to finance food festivals in local communities, increasing sales for local producers, expanding their markets and strengthening the food culture amongst the local population.
- Utilise enforcement tools, ranging from business guidance to legal actions, to ensure compliance with food-related regulations.

Food system linkage considerations

- Coordinate with local authority education teams to build local skills and employment in the food sector.
- Strengthen ties with academia and education institutions in North Wales as a means of translating skills and training into career progression and job creation.
- Explore role of County farms in developing skills, creating jobs and strengthening the local economy.
- Explore the role of 5G and low carbon technologies in strengthening the local food economy.
